The Fox C-6 School District provides a wide range of special education programs and related services for students with disabilities, beginning upon their third birthday through the age of twenty-one (21). A continuum of free and appropriate educational services (FAPE) is available to all disabled students, including those attending private/parochial schools. All programs considerations and services are determined through the Individual Education Program (IEP) process. Fox C-6 School District residents may obtain specific information about special education services by contacting the building principal at the school in their attendance area. Eligible disability conditions include:

- Autism**
- Behavior Disorders/Emotional Disturbance**
- Deaf/Blindness**
- Hearing Impairment/Deaf**
- Learning Disability**
- Mental Retardation/Intellectual Disability**
- Multiple Disabilities**
- Other Health Impairment**
- Orthopedic Impairment**
- Speech/Language Impairment**
- Traumatic Brain Injury**
- Young Child with a Developmental Delay**

Your assistance is needed in young children with disabilities below the age of 5 years. Schools need to be aware of these children so that they can be evaluated and receive appropriate services upon their third birthday.
